	Consider joining new activities or clubs that spark your interest or are related to your major.
	Take the PSAT in October and share your score with your consultant.
	Use the College Connect Form/Application Tracker to research at least 15 colleges (including virtual tours).
	Plan a college tour with your family at least once this semester or on school break.
